Meadville Lombard will have a unique opportunity to address the Unitarian Universalist community when it presents **The Call for a New Reformation** panel discussion at Plenary Session IV at General Assembly. The panel will include President Lee Barker, Professors John Tolley and Michael Hogue, Chaplain Nan Hobart, recent graduate Bill Neely, and current student Ellen Cooper-Davis.

This session will look at how religion is used to promote violence and hatred.
