Reservations and payment for rooms are the responsibility of the individual(s) occupying the guest rooms. **When making reservations, you must reference “Large Church Intensive”** to receive the group rate. The rates noted do not include taxes.

**Executive Suite** (\$99 per night) has one queen bed (accommodates up to 2 people)

**Double Suite** (\$119 per night) has 2 full beds - (accommodates up to 4 people)

**Deluxe Suite** (\$119 per night) has one king bed and a double sofa bed in the living room (accommodates up to 4 people)

The hotel is located less than 5 miles from the church and is in close proximity to North Park Center, a major regional shopping center [www.northparkcenter.com](http://www.northparkcenter.com).

**Airport and Local Transportation**

Dallas is served by two airports; DFW airport (code: DFW) is the large regional airport between Dallas and Ft. Worth. All major carriers provide service to DFW except Southwest Airlines.

Love Field (code: DAL) is the airport in the city of Dallas located about 5 miles from the church. It is primarily served by Southwest Airlines; with recent changes in legislation, American Airlines is now flying out of Love Field. Currently, this addition has provided consumers with rate competition from selected markets. This could be helpful to those making early travel plans.

There are a variety of transportation offerings including shuttle services, taxis, and rental cars. If you are interested in a rental car, discounted rates can often be found online at Internet travel services (e.g., [www.hotwire.com](http://www.hotwire.com)) rather than the car rental websites.

To/from hotel from/to Love Field: \$17 per person

Taxi to/from hotel from/to Love Field: \$15 each
