David Hicks MacPherson was born in Boston in 1928. A Universalist, he graduated from Tufts University in 1950. He received an STB from the Crane Theological School and was ordained in 1952. He served congregation in Foxborough, MA; Silver Springs and Lutherville, MD; Richmond, VA; Brookfield, WI and Waynesburg, VA. In 1961 he received of the Clarence R. Skinner Award, and during the 1970's (until 1981) he was a member of the Virginia State Advisory Committee to the United States Commission on Civil Rights. Now retired, he lives in Ashland, VA.
